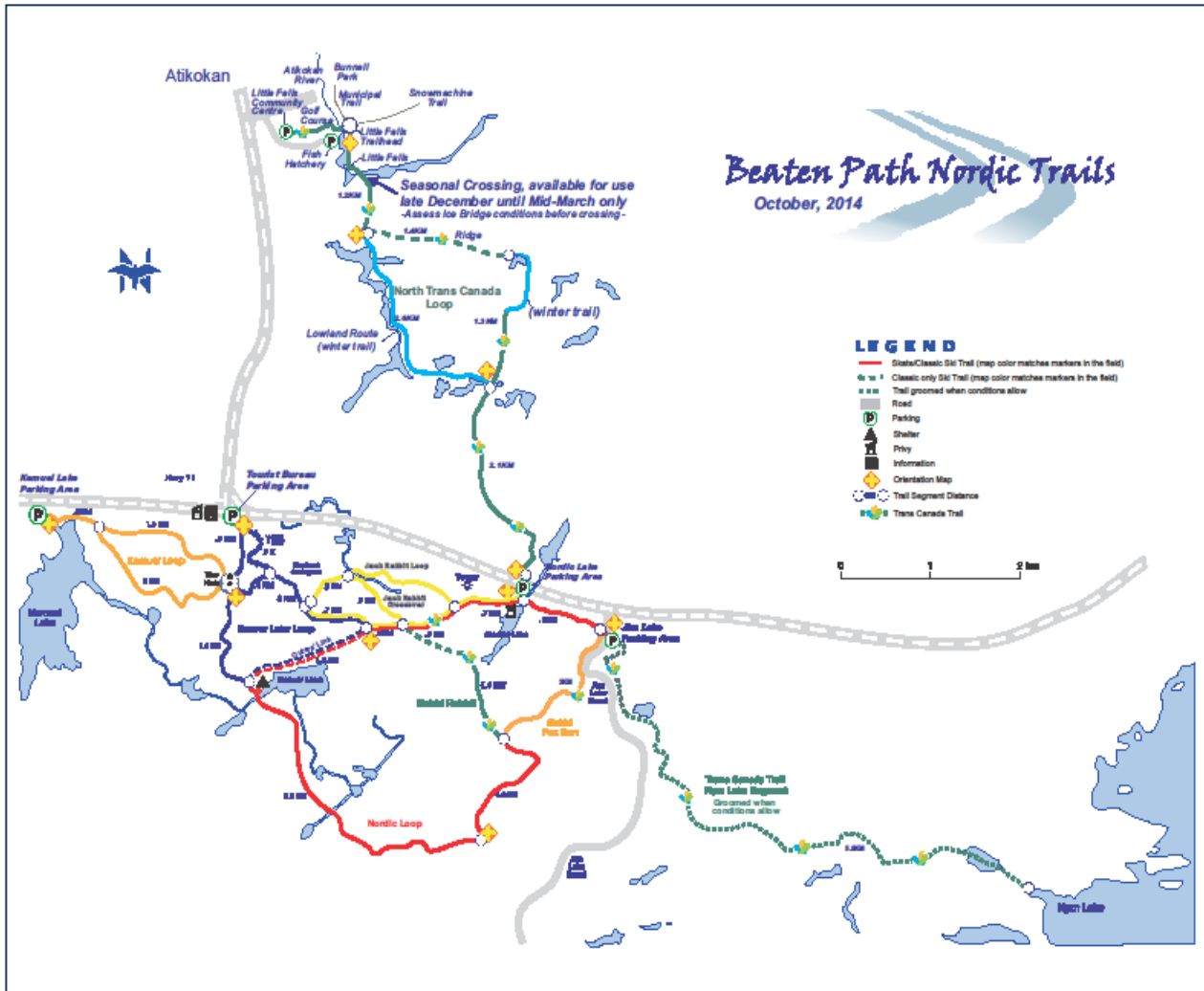

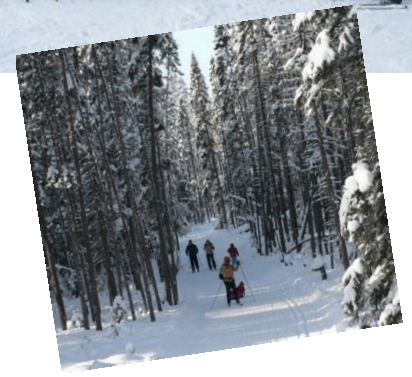


Beaten Path Nordic Trails

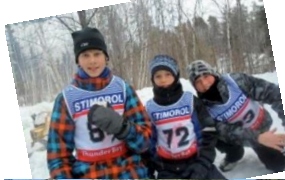

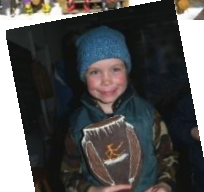

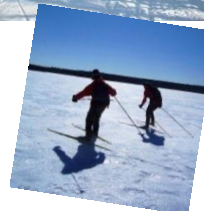
